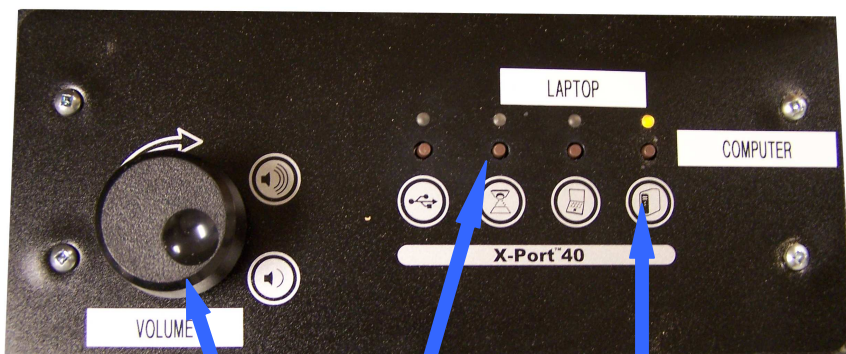


Connecting a Laptop

These laptop connections are located on the top of the cabinet:



This selection panel is located beside the laptop connections panel:

Source Icons

Start with your laptop turned OFF.

If you need power and you have your power adapter with you, plug it into the **POWER OUTLET**.

If you need access to the network or the Internet, pull out the **NETWORK** cable and plug into your laptop's network port.

Pull out the **VIDEO** cable and plug it into the Video/Monitor port on your laptop.

If you need to play audio on your computer, pull out the **AUDIO** cable and plug into your laptop's headphone jack.

If you have the SMART Board software loaded on your laptop and you are going to use the Sympodium touch screen, pull out the **USB** cable and plug it into one of your laptop's USB ports.

Now turn on your laptop.

Once your laptop is on, push the source selection button located above the laptop icon on the selection panel. This will switch the projected image as well as the image on Sympodium monitor from the computer to your laptop. When done please switch it back to the computer.

If you cannot see your laptop image displayed on the projector, you will need to press the "Fn" key and the appropriate "F" key for your laptop to turn on the Video/Monitor port.

When finished, unplug everything, **making sure you have switched the source back to the computer.**
